

**From the LVPOA General Manager:**

The August 2010 Open Meeting of the LVPOA Board of Directors was Thursday, August 12, at 7pm in the Bluebonnet Room of the Activity Center.

**LVPOA Board Elections:** Meet the Candidates night will be held at K Oaks Clubhouse on Monday, September 20, 2010, at 7pm. Candidates will be available to present their qualifications and answer questions. Please plan to take advantage of this opportunity to learn more about the LVPOA Board candidates.

**Parks:** We are continuing to see members as well as guests attempting to use Cody and other LVPOA parks to launch watercraft. Launching of watercraft from trailers is strictly prohibited in LVPOA parks; we have 3 launch ramps open and we respectfully request that members and their guests use those ramps. Launching and recovering watercraft from the park shores causes serious damage to the parks and is disrespectful of the parkland as well as other members' interests. We will continue to station a Ranger at Cody on the weekends to turn away trailers with watercraft.

**Requests for Use of Facilities:** The Board approved modification of the reservation policy; for 2011 property owners in good standing may reserve any facility for the use of the member or the member's direct relatives (ie. parents, children, grandchildren, etc.) for private parties or functions, by written request. Additionally, beginning in 2011, no more than one (1) reservation/event per property owner will be allowed during a calendar year. Requests for exemption may be made to the Board and will be considered on the merits of the request.

**Boy Scouts:** The North Shore Order of the Arrow donated \$250 to the LVPOA for allowing them to use the Bar K facilities in March. Whenever the Scouts use LVPOA parks, they help clean the park and leave it looking even better than before they used it; the Board and Staff would like to thank the Scouts for their efforts.

**Meeting with the City of Lago Vista:** The City of Lago Vista has drafted a Parks and Recreation Master Plan regarding which the City will hold a public hearing on August 19, 2010. The LVPOA Board plans to attend the meeting to voice their concerns and questions regarding the Plan. The LVPOA Board looks forward to additional public meetings with the City to discuss plans for public parks and facilities in Lago Vista.
